Help us frame the community-led walk & ride, to achieve its stated purpose:


- 1. **for policy makers and technical staff** of public agencies **to be informed** by the affected constituencies





Riverdale Park: ½ mile station area







Darker green signifies **higher** population density, while lighter green signifies **lower** population density. The map on the right is zoomed in, focusing on the block groups surrounding **Riverdale Park Purple Line Station**, as shown by the symbol.




Riverdale Station Walkshed Map

- 15 minutes (yellow)






Riverdale Park: Signalized Intersections


- MD 410 & MD 201

Note: "Condition" of crosswalk is not shown; many appear to need maintenance, upgrade to high visibility.








NC Riverdale Park: Channelized Turns




Riverdale Park: Wide Radius Corners

Proposed improvements


NCSG Proposed Improvements: MDOT/SHA/MTA

 Full 4-way intersection at MD 201 and River Rd/Tuckerman, but only 1 crosswalk

 New sidewalks along both sides of MD 201 between River Rd and MD 410

 Full 4-way crosswalks at Kenilworth and Rittenhouse (already signalized)

 Consolidation of staggered intersection at Riverdale Rd (MD 410) and 63rd Ave with 4way crosswalks.





Key Outstanding Gaps/Uncertainties: State Focus on MD 410 and MD 201

- Sidewalk treatment along parts of 410 and 201NOT carrying the Purple Line
- Sidewalk width, proximity to curb lane traffic (esp 410 eastbound)
- Signal spacing (1/4 mile), timing and pedestrian cycles
- Speed limits and enforcement plans
- Management of channelized turns, wide radius corners
- Design and management of criticalintersections at Kenilworth and MD 410, Kenilworth and Riverdale Rd
- Curb cuts number and marking/management (state or county?)

Proposed Improvements: Prince George's County

Intersection Improvement Bike Lane- Recommended Cycle Track- Recommended Roadway- Recommended Sidepath- Recommended Sidewalk- Recommended Shared Use Path- Recommended Shared Use Roadway- Recommended Bike Lanes- Planned Shared Use Roadways- Planned Hard Surface Trails- Planned/Existing Natural Surface Trails- Planned Side Paths- Planned

2011 Corridor Access (CAST) Study





Key Outstanding Gaps/Uncertainties: County

Status of 2011 Cast Study recommendations:

- Correlation/coordination between county and state plans RE state highways (sidewalks, crosswalks, signalization)
- Connectivity between population "quadrants" to PL station (esp Riverdale Rd, Megamart parking lots)
- Sidewalk and intersection recommendations in neighborhoods (esp northeast)
- Development plans for immediate station area
- Dealing with curb cuts, parking consolidation
- Integration of new & existing transit services
